Students in receipt of successful applications should submit a student expense claim form (available from the University of Glasgow Finance Office web-site) no later than 2 months after the date of their trip. This must be accompanied by all relevant receipts and submitted to Lynn Kearns, Departmental Administrator, Department of Chemistry.
